## Fees

**The fee per camper is \$190.** Total camper fees must be paid by May 15th or a late fee of \$15 will apply. All Maverick scouts (provisional scouts staying at camp without their adult troop leadership) pay \$210 per camper fee.

To request and hold a site, a **deposit of \$100** must be paid. **There are no roll over deposits.** The deposit will be applied to the total final fees. Use the form on the back of this brochure to reserve your site.

## Beyond Merit Badges

We don't just measure success in terms of the number of Merit Badges a scout can earn; they can also earn the Totin' Chip and Firem'n Chit. We offer American Red Cross C.P.R., Mile Swim, Lifeguard B.S.A. for youth & adults, the Oklahoma Certified Hunter Safety Program, the Paul Bunyan Axemanship Award, and adult leader training courses.

We have a full Honor Unit program and many special recreational opportunities from Horse-shoes to Volleyball.
