The dates for summer camp are June 13th-19th. The cost is \$250 for scouts and \$100 for adults.

We're also hosting a maverick campsite for any camper who cannot go to summer camp with their troop! All maverick campers will come together throughout the week and act as a troop with leadership given by other adult volunteers and camp staff. All maverick campers will have the same opportunities as other scouts, so sign up now to get a second week of summer camp in! Troops sending 3 or more Scouts need to provide 1 adult leader to assist.

Do you have an older Scout that is not be interested in attending camp? Encourage them to apply for a staff position. Staff applications are available from the Camp Director or on the Council website.

To reserve a spot for your Unit, submit your campsite reservation and \$100 deposit per Unit. This deposit is non-refundable, and will be deducted from your overall cost of camp. Half of the fee balance is due by April 2, 2021 and the remaining is due by May 1, 2021. The campsite reservation form can be found on the website.
