# GENERAL INFORMATION

- WHAT:** The annual Yale Civil War Reenactment Encampment. This is an opportunity for scouts to experience a Civil War Reenactment.
- WHEN:** Friday, February 19th through Sunday, February 21nd. Registration starts at 5:00 PM on Friday. Reenactment events start at 9:00 am on Saturday. Troops are welcome to depart any time on Sunday after securing & cleaning their campsite. Jim Thorpe Park in Yale OK On Highway 51.
- WHERE:**
- WHO:** All Troops, Teams, Venturers, and 2<sup>nd</sup> Year Webelos may camp if visiting a Boy Scout Troop
- COST:** Program cost for the Encampment is \$15.00 if registration form sent in and fees paid at the Enid Council Service Center no later than February 5<sup>th</sup>. After February 5<sup>th</sup>, registration is \$18.00 per person (parent, leader, scout, sibling). Food & Ice are supplied by units. Camporee fee includes patch, Port-a-potties, battle admission, and event insurance. Extra patches may be available.
- LEADERSHIP:** Each Unit should be under the supervision of "two deep adult leadership," a Scoutmaster or other qualified adult leader (minimum 21 years of age) who will remain at the event for the entire weekend. The 2<sup>nd</sup> adult must be over age 18.
- EQUIPMENT:** Each unit will be responsible for their transportation, camping equipment and food. Some campsites have shelters and others have Picnic tables.
- CAMPSITE:** To be assigned by Camporee staff at registration. Tommy Gripe is responsible for checking in each troop that arrives.
- VEHICLES:** Vehicles parked in designated parking areas.
- ELECTRICITY** None - bring lantern and flashlights.
- LATRINES:** Latrines are provided by the council and available at key locations. The park also has several permanent restroom facilities.
- FIRST AID:** It is recommended that each unit bring their own First Aid Kit.
- INSURANCE:** The Encampment fee includes accident insurance coverage. Please let us know if you have any medical emergencies in your campsite. If you need help with this or have questions, please call Lori Brown at (405) 258-6611.
- NOT CAMPING:** Some units, including Cub Scouts may not want to camp overnight. You are welcomed to be with us just for the reenactment on Saturday. Be sure to check into our headquarters when you arrive. The same \$15.00 (\$18.00 if paid on site) registration fee applies.
- SECURITY** We are camping in a public city park with many guests and visitors. Troops must use a buddy system during the weekend. Review your safety guidelines with each scout. Report suspicious people to the camp headquarters. Yale City Police will patrol the park all weekend.
