Participation: All registered Boy Scouts may attend this event. All participants (Scouts/Leaders) will need to have a Health Form (Part A and B) on file.

Registration: \$25.00 for Boy Scouts and \$10.00 Adult Leaders

Pre-registration will need to be turned in to the Scout office by Friday, March 9, 2018

Late registration received after March 9th will have a **\$5** late registration fee added to each registration.

Scouts will need to bring their own tents we will have an area set aside for them to set their tent up in for the weekend. Flashlights, walking shoes, and water bottle, physicals and any personal gear are needed. Open toed shoes are not allowed on camp. Scouts will need to bring pen and paper.
