- Who:** Registered adult leaders who have completed the basic training required for their current position and 18+ year-old Venturers.
- What:** Wood Badge strengthens Scouting by empowering adult leaders with tools they need to serve the youth in their Packs, Troops, Teams, Crews, Posts. Strong units grow Scouting. It is a leadership training course that focuses on leadership rather than outdoor skills and leads participants to:
- View Scouting globally, as a family of interrelated, values-based youth programs,
 - Recognize and utilize contemporary leadership concepts relevant to the Scouting movement,
 - Apply the skills they learn as a member of a successful working team, and
 - Revitalize their commitment to provide the leadership Scouting needs to accomplish its mission now and in the future.
- To complete the course, participants must attend two 3-day sessions and complete their “ticket”. This “ticket” is the participant’s commitment to complete a set of personal goals to strengthen themselves, as a Scout leader, and the Scouting program in which they participate.
- Where:** Will Rogers Scout Reservation (located on the north side of Highway 64 about 4.5 miles west of Cleveland, OK or about 1 mile east of the junction of Highway 99 & Highway 64).
